

Switzkill Farm Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations have been developed to insure that Switzkill Farm remains beautiful, inviting, and safe for the community. Use of Switzkill Farm is intended for recreation, nature observation, research, social and cultural gatherings, and education.

Hours

Switzkill Farm is open daily from dawn to dusk
Nighttime use is allowed only with a permit obtained from the Town Clerk

Motorized Vehicles

Parking is allowed in designated areas only
Motorized vehicles are allowed on roadways and in designated parking areas only

Buildings

Use of buildings requires an application and approval from the Town Clerk

Animals

Feeding, hunting, trapping, fishing or disturbing wildlife is prohibited.
Dogs must be licensed, current on vaccinations, and must be leashed, or under verbal control, at all times.
Dog owners must carry a leash and pick up and remove pet waste.
Horses are permitted on designated trails only and must yield to other trail users

Permits Required

Nighttime use is allowed with permit issued by Town Clerk

Fires and charcoal cooking are allowed in grills only

Grills must be at least 12" off the ground
Live coals must be extinguished or placed in the hot coal container on site

Trail Use

Horses and bicycles must yield to other trail users
Horses and bicycles are only permitted on trails designated for them

Weapons and Fireworks

Weapons, firearms, or their discharge are prohibited. Weapons include spring or air-activated weapons, or weapons that propel projectiles by use of bow or sling, explosives, or jet or rocket propulsion.

Trash

A Carry in—Carry Out policy is in effect for all trash generated except for activities taking place in park buildings.
All beverage and food items, their containers, wrappers, and other trash must be removed from the property by the patron

Switzkill Farm Rules and Regulations

Prohibited Activities

Disturbing, injuring, or endangering the comfort, health, peace or safety of other users is prohibited.

Smoking and vaping are prohibited

Glass containers are prohibited anywhere on site.

Collecting firewood is prohibited.

Patrons may not destroy, damage, or remove trees, including dead or downed trees.

Swimming in the ponds is prohibited.

Collecting, removing, destroying or defacing any natural or manmade object is prohibited.

All illegal activities are prohibited, and violators will be prosecuted.

Alcoholic beverages are not allowed.

Fireworks are prohibited anywhere on the property.

All persons must evacuate the property when ordered by an official of the Town, County or State.
