Public Hearing for Proposed Local Law #3-2023 Tax Cap Override

At 6:01PM Deputy Town Supervisor Clayton called the meeting to order and took role call attendance Councilmembers Doolin and Thiem were in attendance. Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Deputy Supervisor Clayton opened the floor for public commentary pertaining to Proposed Local Law 3-2023.

Barbara Hoerning – Lifelong resident who is 86 years old stated her and her husband live on a fixed income and wonder where they will find the money to pay for the increase.

Sally Meduna also had concerns about living on a fixed income and expressed worry on how she will pay for the increase.

Debra Flagler asked what kind of increase was expected and where the money will go.

Krista Safford said as a lifetime resident she has a lot of questions but mostly wanted to express her concern for the families already struggling.

Deputy Supervisor Clayton stated that per the New York State Comptroller the Tax Cap can increase 2% each year, if the need to increase is greater than 2% a Local Law is required to be adopted.

Deputy Supervisor Clayton made a motion seconded by Councilmember Thiem to close the Public Hearing for Proposed Local Law # 3 of 2023, Deputy Supervisor Clayton and Councilmembers Doolin & Thiem voting aye.
