☐ Habitually chase, run alongside of or bark at bike riders or other moving vehicles while such vehicles are on a public street or highway or upon public or private property other than property of the owner or harbinger of said dog in violation of Town Code § 75-4 (B)(4);

☐ Create a nuisance by defecating, urinating or digging on public property or private property other than the property of the owner or harbinger of said dog in violation of Town Code § 75-4 (B)(5); and/or

☐ If a female dog, be off the owner's property when the dog is in heat, unless the dog is accompanied by its owner in violation of Town Code § 75-4 (B)(6).
